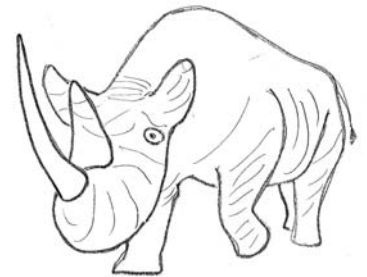

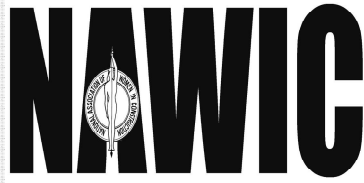
Block Kids 2011

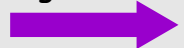
