Visit the construction site which will soon house a new 200,000-sq-ft expansion to add galleries, public space and an underground parking garage with 300 below-grade parking spaces to the St. Louis Art Museum.

Tarlton managed shoring and excavation 35 ft deep and 5 ft off the existing structure, originally built for the 1904 World's Fair. Temporary shoring was used to hold the structure in place, and vibrations inside the museum are continuously monitored by seismographs inside the building. Due for completion in 2012, the project is a joint venture with Pepper Construction, Chicago, and KAI,
